These trainings were meant to create a critical mass of community actors in instituting citizen-led demand for accountability in the management of public resources. We trained in the 5 wards of Munali Constituency, where we are based, having adopted Munali as a microcosm of the nation.



Under the EU funded Speak Up Zambia Project, jointly implemented with Free Press Unlimited and House of Consciousness, we train young people to act as citizen journalist, reporting service delivery issues in their communities. In January we were in Livingstone with Radio Mosi-oa-Tunya

ACA raised strong exception to Patriotic Front (PF) Secretary General Davies Mwila's reported instruction to PF councillors to give preference to party members in the distribution of land in Kabwe. At the same gathering, he was quoted as advocating for the forceful removal of opposition party members from bus stations and other trading places in Kabwe. All Citizens have a right to fair access to public resources





on 24th August ACA Director, Laura Miti was on the panel of discussants at a public talk on the WE CAN BE theme, 'Challenges of Democracy in Zambia' organised by Voice of America and hosted by 'Straight Talk Africa' anchor Shaka Ssali at the University of Zambia. Other panellists were media practitioner and lawyer Dickson Jere, political science lecturer Lee Habasonda and University of Zambia Student Union (UNZASU) vice-president Piyo Ndhlovu.

The central idea of the Access to Justice-ASK Youth is to have more youths in rural areas, specifically; Isoka and Mpika districts of Muchinga Province apply for scholarships and education loans (former bursaries). The project is funded by the European Union Programme through the Zambian Governance Foundation (ZGF).

The ACA was awarded a new grant for our new initiative, 'Access to Justice: Ask Youth Project.'




**#NoDeputyMinsiters** ACA reminded citizens to stay vigilant


A week later, the ACA hosted a Youth Insaka at which young people discussed how they can increase the demand for accountability.
